



Cleaning and Maintenance of Classen Vinyl Floorings

Appropriate cleaning and maintenance tailored to the grade of the use help the optics of your Classen vinyl floorings remain at the same quality level over a long period of time.

Classen Vinyl Floorings with Surface Protection

Classen vinyl floorings are provided with a surface protection already in the factory and they don't need the initial maintenance.

Thanks to this surface protection, the floorings exhibit a particularly good behaviour during cleaning and maintenance, which renders the first maintenance prior to the beginning of use needless and serves as a basis for the future maintenance and care. The ideal prerequisites for modern and cost-effective cleaning methods are thereby fulfilled.

1 Preventive Measures

85% of dirt is brought into the building on shoes. The dirt ingress by shoes and wear caused by sand, splinters and other particles with abrasive effect can be prevented by placing door mats or carpets which serve as cleaning zones.

2 Cleaning of Newly Installed Floor

Once the laying process is performed, the floorings are cleaned with damp cloth soaked in water to which a neutral cleaning agent is added (please comply with manufacturer's recommendations). By no means may thinners be used for removal of stains.

3 Regular Cleaning

A dry, soft broom and a vacuum-cleaner with hard floor attachment are suitable for removal of coarse dirt. Dirt particles which adhere to the flooring should be removed by a well wrung-out mop or floor wipe.

4 General Instructions

- Areas of contact with furniture should be protected by pressure absorbing underlays of appropriate size.
- Chemicals of all kind such as solvents, medicinal drugs and disinfection agents, hair dye, tea, fats, pencil or marker ink etc., can permanently stain the floorings.
- Direct contact of the floorings with the material made of dyed rubber, such as dirt absorbing mats or rubber caps on devices, chair or table legs, can permanently stain the floorings. Contact points should therefore be protected. This should also be done with products made of terracotta.
- Glowing cigarette remains may cause damage to the flooring surface.
- Direct solar irradiation as well as intensive artificial light may cause discolouration of all floorings.

- The flooring has to have additional features when Classen vinyl floorings are used in special areas (e.g. suitable for chair castors in offices).
- Recommendations of the manufacturer of cleaning agents to be used have to be observed at all times.
